The Safety of Our Children

Remember the saying, "It takes a village to raise a child"? Or the recount in the Gospels of Jesus' tender encounters with children and His great expressions of love for them? It is with this same care that the newly initiated ACTS Board thought it was important to remind everyone of the policies that were put into place in regard to a safe environment for our children while assisting or accompanying their parents at ACTS Retreats and social functions. These policies were put into place not only because of the Catholic Diocese of Juneau's published Safe Environment Policy (1) but most importantly because of several incidences that have occurred in the past that have put our children at very high risk of falling victim to sexual predators. Yes, right here in our safe community of Juneau, our children have been exposed to this horrendous crime. It is for this reason mainly that the Board over the last few years felt it was imperative to put into place certain policies in regard to children and ACTS functions:

- 1) No children under the age of 18 are allowed to assist with meal preparation or serve meals at the camp where a Men's or Women's Retreat is being held (even if they are present with a parent or guardian). This is the only way we can allow Adult retreatants to attend without each and every one having to undergo a background check. In a recent Safe Environment training provided by the Diocese of Juneau, many of us learned that sexual predators suffer from a mental

illness that is difficult to treat and putting them in the presence of children under any circumstance can be harmful. And, putting children into an uncontrolled environment can be extremely harmful to them as well.

- 2) Childcare will no longer be offered in the Lodge at the Shrine of St. Therese during the Candlelight Service. We cannot control who is on the Shrine premises. However, it may be offered at the Parish Hall by adults who have undergone safe environment training and have undergone a background check.

Finally, though it is not a policy, it is strongly urged that parents and/or guardians never leave their young children unattended at or around the Church area during Masses, potlucks, picnics or other social gatherings. There have been occurrences of registered sex offenders who have been present during these events at and around the grounds of the Church and in the Gathering Space area of the Church.

Again, we present this information to you with great love and concern for all of our children. Not to scare you or put you off from attending ACTS functions but to be keenly aware of where your children are and who is caring for them so that all of us will be safe. If you have any questions in regard to these policies please contact any of the Board members listed in this Newsletter. And please always remember to pray for safety for all of God's children, young or old, and for the Board that they continue to consider Jesus' great love for all of us in their endeavor to set and make policies that affect all of us on our faith journeys.
